

Boston 7

The object of the game is for the player to achieve a higher poker hand than the dealer using the best 5 out of 7 cards according to the standard rules of poker.

RULES:

A single standard deck of playing cards will be used when dealing Boston 7.

To start the game, each player must place an Ante Bonus Wager and a 1st Wager. The Ante Bonus wager and the 1st Wager must be of equal amounts. Each player and the dealer will be dealt three cards face down.

Players who choose to wager on the Three Card Bonus must place their wager prior to receiving any cards. Players that have a qualifying Three Card Bonus hand must place their hand face up on the table in order for the dealer to award them their bonus. Players will be paid according to the Three Card Bonus pay table below. No Three Card Bonus claims will be allowed once the dealer has dealt the final four cards.

After players view their first three cards, they have the option to fold or place a 2nd Wager equal to their 1st Wager. A player who does not pay for all seven cards must fold, thus losing the Ante Bonus wager and 1st Wager. Player's who have made a 2nd Wager will receive their final four cards dealt face down.

If a player has paid for all seven cards, the player's hand is then compared to the dealer's hand. The higher poker hand wins. In the event of a tie, the hand is a push. When the dealer's hand beats the player's hand, the dealer collects the Ante Bonus wager, 1st wager and 2nd wager. When the player's hand beats the dealer's hand, the player retains their Ante Bonus wager, players will then be paid an equal amount on their 1st and 2nd wagers, an additional amount will be paid on the Ante Bonus based on the highest single payout for a hand a player achieves according to the Ante Bonus pay table below.

Should a player achieve a bonus hand using the best 5 out of 7 cards, and the dealer has a higher hand using their best 5 out of 7 cards, the player shall still receive their Ante Bonus award, however, the dealer will then collect the Ante Bonus Wager, 1st wager and 2nd wager.

Players are responsible for disclosing a hand consisting of a 7 Card Royal or a 6 Card Royal. No 7 Card Royal or 6 Card Royal Bonus claims will be allowed once the cards are collected by the dealer.
