

Hold'em 3 Bonus

The object of the game is for the player to achieve a higher five card poker hand than the dealer by combining their three hole cards with the four community cards

RULES:

A single standard deck of playing cards will be used when dealing Hold'em 3 Bonus.

To start the game each player must place equal bet amounts on the Blind Bonus spot and the spot marked Flop.

Players have the option of wagering on the 3 Card Bonus side bet and the 6 Card Bonus side bet. Players must make each bonus wager prior to receiving any cards. Players who qualify for the 3 card bonus award must place their cards face up on the table prior to seeing any of the flop cards. The dealer will settle each winning 3 card bonus wager according to the Three Card Bonus pay table. Players who qualify for a 6 card bonus award will be paid after all of the community cards are revealed according to the 6 Card Bonus pay table.

Each player and dealer will be dealt three cards face down. After players view their three cards, the dealer will reveal two of the four community cards. Players have the option of folding thus losing their Blind Bonus wager and Flop wager. Should a player decide to see the final two community cards, they have the option of betting 1x their Flop bet or 2x their Flop bet on the Turn/River spot.

If a player has paid for all four community cards, the dealer starting with the player furthest to his right will combine the players three hole cards with the four community cards, and his own three hole cards with the four community cards to determine the players best 5 card poker hand that will challenge the dealers best 5 card poker hand.

In the event of a tie hand, the hand is a push. When the dealer's hand beats the player's hand, the dealer collects the Flop wager and the Turn/River wager. Should the players hand not qualify for a Blind Bonus award the dealer will also collect the Blind Bonus wager.

When the player's hand beats the dealer's hand, the player retains their Blind Bonus wager, Flop wager, and the Turn/River wager. Players will then be paid even money on the Flop wager and the Turn/River wager. Should a player qualify for a Blind Bonus award they will receive an additional amount paid **ONLY** on the Blind Bonus spot based on the highest single payout for a hand they achieve according to the Blind Bonus pay table.

Players are guaranteed their Blind Bonus award and will retain their Blind Bonus wager even if the dealer ties or beats their hand.
